



All routes (1-4) run 7 days a week.

Routes have been the same since 1962, apart from 28/10/2000 - 1/1/2004 when route 5 (ran Monday to Friday only) was added (Kopli to V-Lõuna), and temporary withdrawal of routes 2 and 4 and addition of route 6 (Kopli to Tondi) 16/5/2005 to 9/9/2005 (see note on far left). Stops marked ●.

This curve not in normal use in either direction since withdrawal of route 5 1/1/04, apart from during period 16/5/2005 until 9/9/2005 when temporary route 6 ran from Kopli to Tondi, during closure of tracks from city centre to Ülemiste for reconstruction (routes 2 and 4 withdrawn during this period).

All trams in use are KT4D Tatra, some with subsequently-added German-built low-floor centre-section. Trams up to no. 123 were new to Tallinn, 124 to 149 were acquired second-hand from former East German systems (124-132 ex-Gera, 1996-7; 133-138 ex-Cottbus, 2004; 139-142 ex-Gera, 2004; 143-149 ex-Erfurt, summer 2006).
